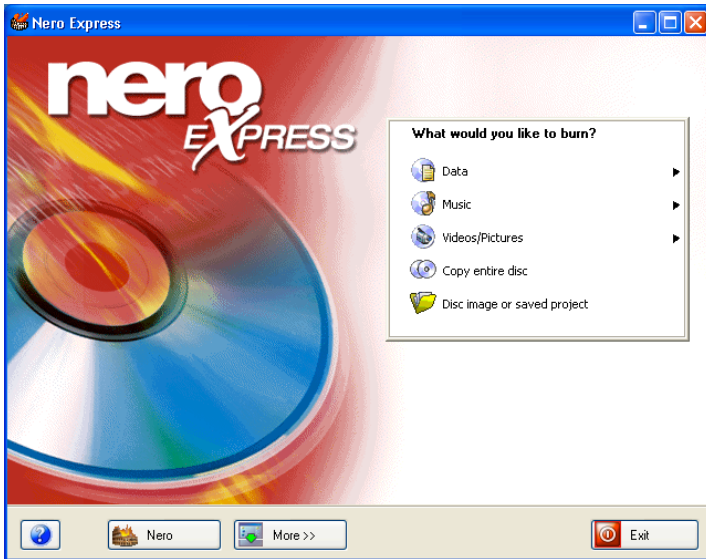


CD Burning Using NERO Express for Windows XP

IMPORTANT!! CD burning is not always an exact procedure and may result in unreadable discs; therefore we, regrettably, cannot refund/replace CDs.

Start **Nero Express** by clicking on: **START-->Programs--> CD-Burning (Nero Express)**



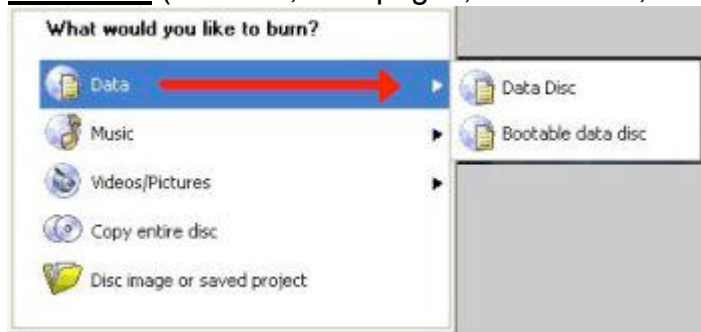
The default options should work fine for the majority of your burning needs. Do not change any of them unless you know what you are doing or you have asked a staff member and they have suggested an alternative setting.

This tutorial will walk you through the process of burning a **"DATA CD"**. The steps involved in burning the other types listed are similar. Ask the staff if you have any doubts.

STEP 1.) Choose the type of CD you would like to burn.

NERO Express allows you to choose from several different options for burning a CD, such as DATA, MUSIC, VIDEO, or COPY ENTIRE DISK

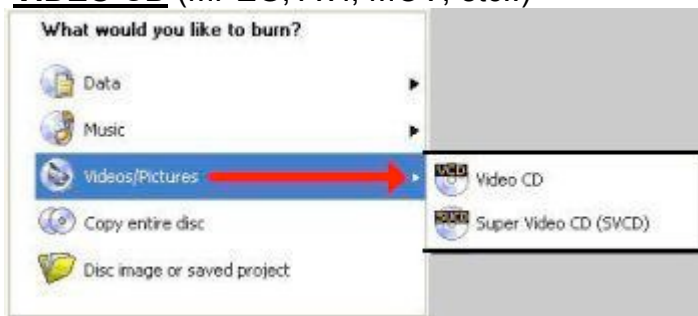
DATA CD (text files, web-pages, data bases, etc..)



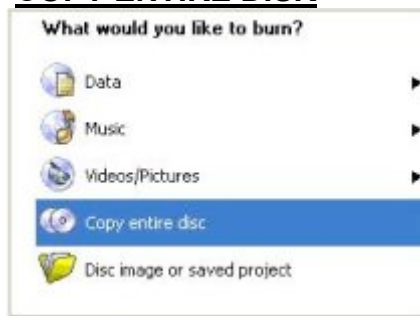
MUSIC CD (WAV, WMA, MP3, etc..)



VIDEO CD (MPEG, AVI, MOV, etc..)



COPY ENTIRE DISK

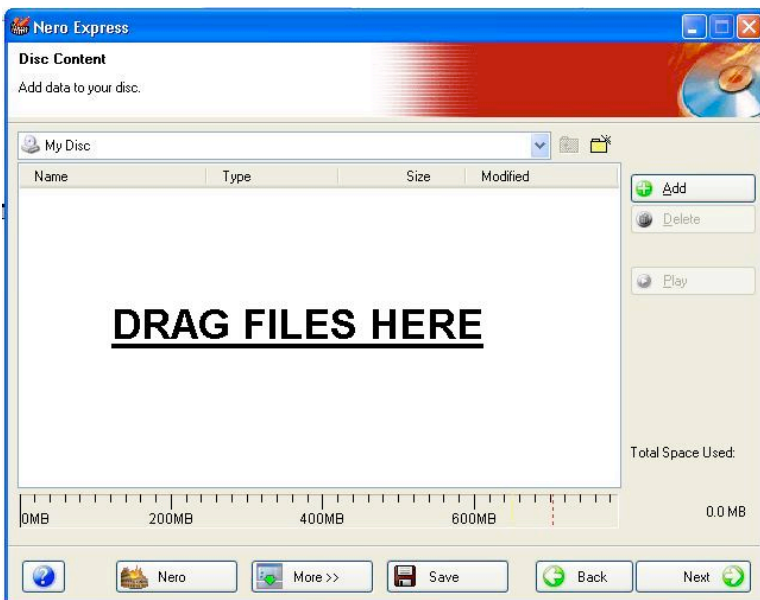


***NOTE*:**
Nero express will not let you copy a CD that is Copyrighted

(if you are in doubt of which option to choose, ask a staff member)

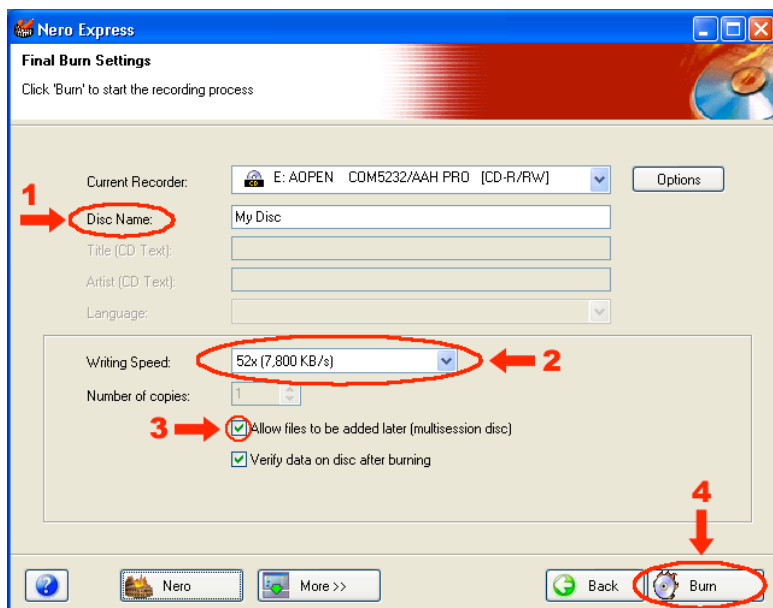
STEP 2.) Choose the files you wish to burn



Click on the “**ADD**” button or **Drag&Drop** your files into the center of the window from Windows Explorer or My Computer.

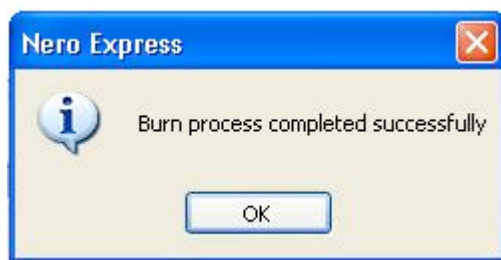
When you have selected all the files that you wish to burn click the “**NEXT**” button in the lower right corner of the screen.

STEP 3.) Choosing your burn options



1. Give your CD a name. Otherwise it will be called “**My Name**”.
2. Choose the speed at which you want to burn. Higher speeds means faster burning, but also means higher probability of the burn failing. Recommended is 8x-12x
3. Make sure that the box marked “**Allow files to be added later (multisession disc)**” is checked, **UNLESS** you are sure that you do not want to add files to this disk at a later date.
4. Click the “**BURN**” button.

Step 4.) The final step



1. Click on the “**OK**” button when the burn success button pops up.
2. Click the “**NEXT**” button in the lower right corner of the screen.
3. You are done!! Choose “**New Project**” if you want to start again or “**EXIT**” the program if you are finished.
